PARKING AND DRIVING AROUND SCHOOL

We would like to remind parents/carers who travel by car that we operate a voluntary one-way system and ask that you DO NOT enter Sancreed Road from Northmere Drive. Please only enter via Newlyn Way. Sancreed Road can become extremely busy and we must be mindful of our neighbours, but most importantly keeping our children safe. Please DO NOT park on the yellow zig-zag markings, block driveways, or park opposite the school gates which are single yellow lines, and definitely NOT on pavements.

HOT MEALS

Hot meals are ordered via the payment system Parent Pay. The deadline for ordering meals is **MONDAY** for the following week. E.g if you want to order for W/C 23rd Sept, the deadline will be Monday 16th Sept. If meals are not ordered, a packed lunch must be provided to ensure we have enough meals for those who have ordered. If your child is in Reception, Yr1 or Yr2 they are entitled to the Universal Free School Meal, however you must still order via Parent Pay.

EARLY BIRDS & LATE OWLS

Bookings for Early Birds (EB) and Late Owls (LO) are made via the payment system Parent Pay. Bookings can be made 24hrs prior to the date required and payment must be made at the time of booking.
